



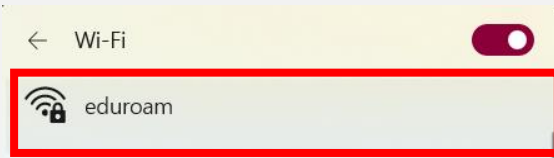

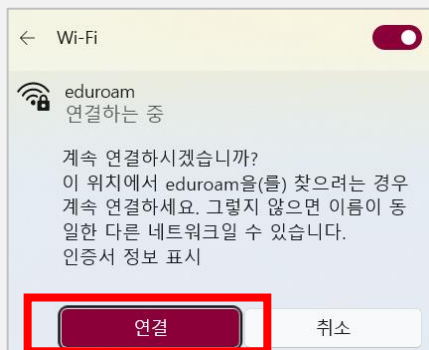

1. Windows User Guide (eduroam, KUWIFI)

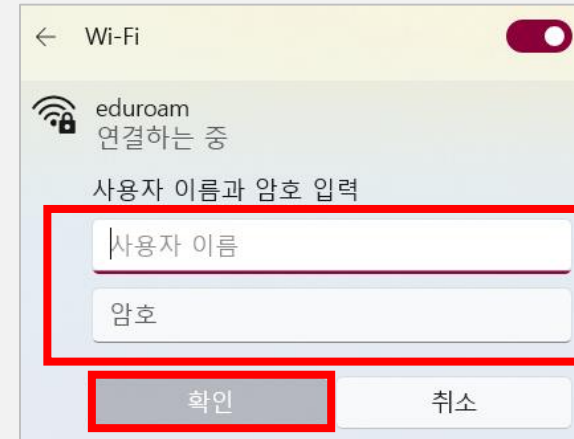


01 Connecting to eduroam or KUWIFI

- The setup process is the same for both eduroam and KUWIFI.
- Click the network icon in the bottom-right corner of your screen.
- From the list of available Wi-Fi networks, select eduroam or KUWIFI.

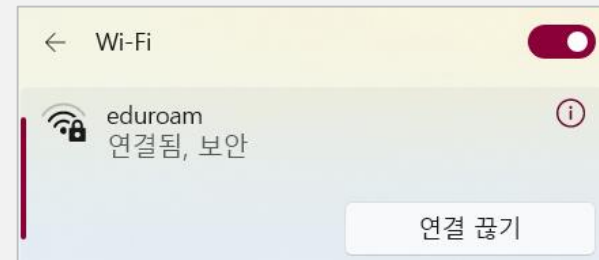


03 Click Connect



02 Enter ID/Password and Connect

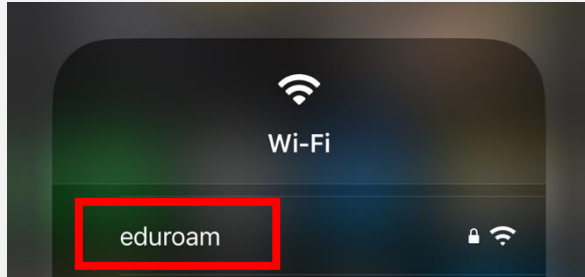

04 Confirm Connection and Use the Internet

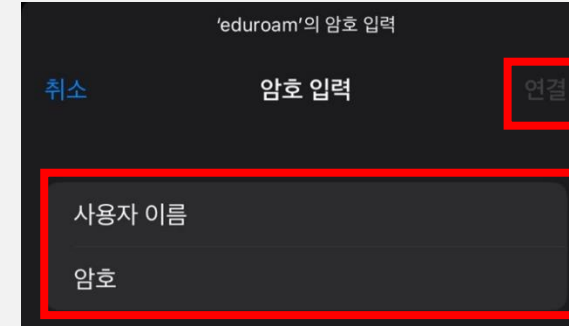

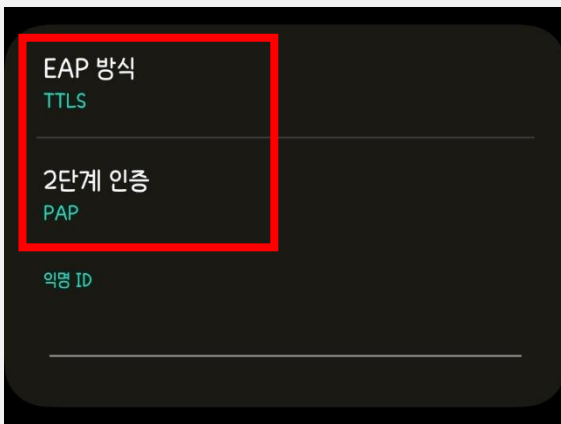
01 Connecting to eduroam or KUWIFI

- Setting > Connect > Wi-Fi or Shortcut Icon



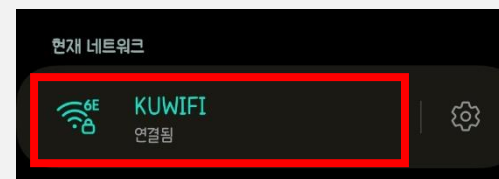
02 Enter ID/Password, CA Certificate

- Username : KUPID ID
 - Password : KUPID password
 - If you forget your password, reset it through the portal.
 - For eduroam users accessing from other institutions, enter **KUPID ID@korea.ac.kr/Password**
 - CA Certificate > **Don't validate**
 - Click Advanced
- ※ If the "Don't validate" option is unavailable, select "System Certificate" and enter "wifissl.korea.ac.kr"



03 Select Authentication Method and Connect

- Select EAP Method > **TTLS**
- If the second-step authentication is not set to PAP, select PAP.
- Click the **Connect** button at the bottom of the scroll.



04 Confirm Connection and Use the Internet

※ The screens may vary depending on the Android version.

4. Guest Usage Guide (KUWIFI_GUEST)

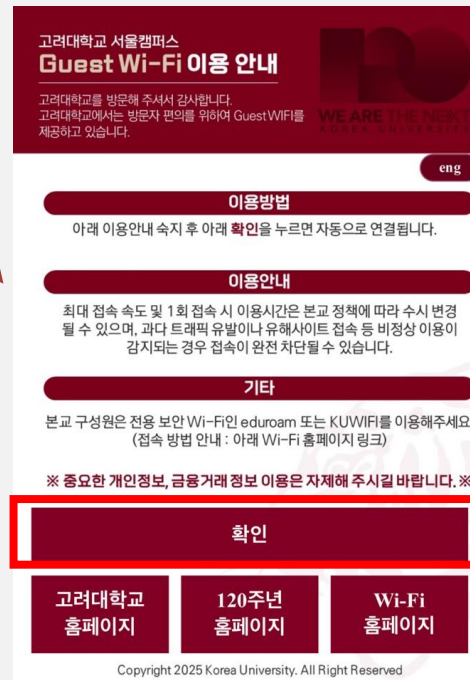
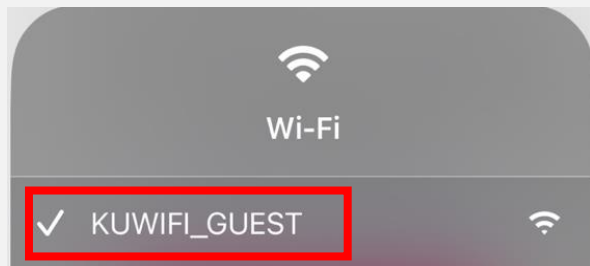
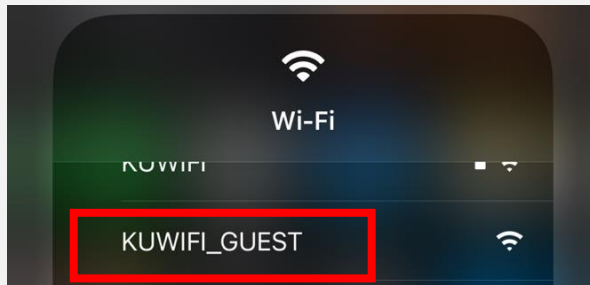
Korea University Visitor (Guest) Wi-Fi is a public service that does not require a separate authentication procedure.

There are limits on the maximum speed and the maximum connection time per session.

If abnormal usage such as excessive traffic or access to harmful websites is detected, access may be completely blocked.

Korea University members must use secure Wi-Fi services like eduroam or KUWIFI.

※ Avoid using the Guest Wi-Fi for sensitive **personal information or financial transactions.**



01 Connecting to KUWIFI_GUEST

- Windows : network icon in the bottom-right > Wi-Fi
- IOS : Setting > Wi-Fi or Shortcut Icon
- Android : Setting > Connect > Wi-Fi or Shortcut Icon

02 After checking the Wi-Fi usage guide, connect and use the internet.

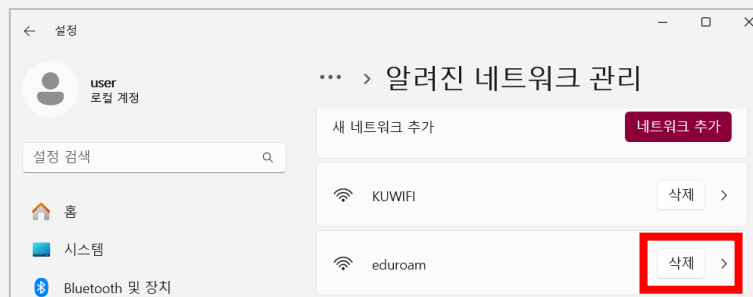
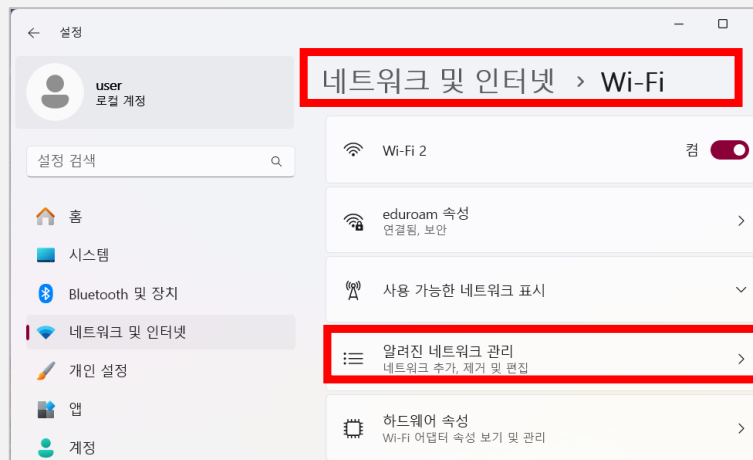
- After checking the information in the popup, click the Confirm button at the bottom
(No IP/PW authentication required)
- Confirm the internet connection and start using it

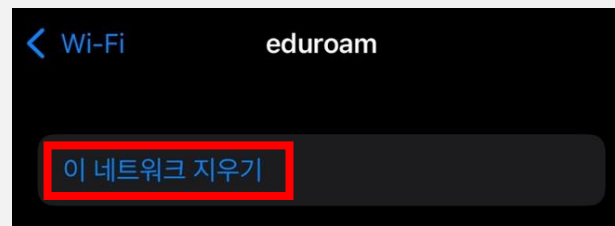
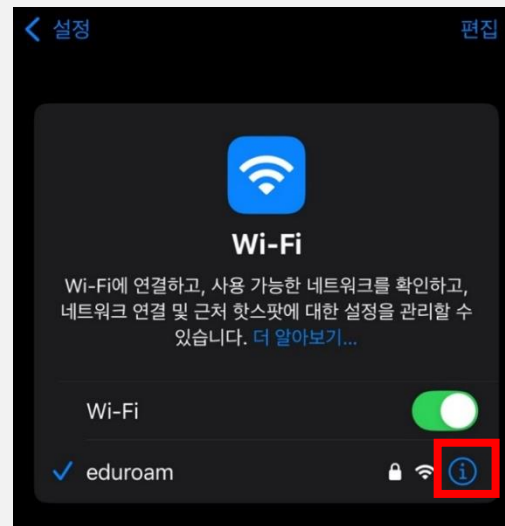
01 Windows SSID Deletion Guide

- Setting > Network & Internet > Wi-Fi > Manage known networks > Delete eduroam or KUWIFI



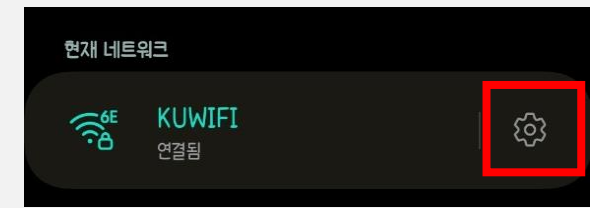
02 IOS(iPhone) SSID Deletion Guide

- Setting > Wi-Fi > Click the right icon of eduroam or KUWIFI > Select Forget this network.

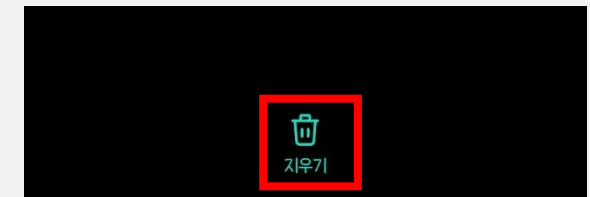


03 Android SSID Deletion Guide

- Setting > Connet > Wi-Fi > Click the right icon of eduroam or KUWIFI > Click Forget at the bottom



※ If there is no right icon, press and hold the Wi-Fi name
